

# How do I get started?

It's quick and easy to get started. First of all you have to get set up. This is a safe and secure process and all your details are carefully protected.

If you're a new Pay As You Go customer, the first thing to do is call 444 on your mobile and activate your SIM card. Pay Monthly customers are already activated.

Then you just press the Skype button on your phone, scroll to [Create account for new users](#) (or, if you already have a Skype account, [Sign in for existing users](#)) and follow the instructions. You'll need to choose a password and username (which people will then use to call you).

Alternatively, you can set up Skype on a PC (visit [www.skype.com](http://www.skype.com) for more details).

Once you're set up you can search for the usernames of your friends and family and get cracking.

## It's free and very easy

The important things to remember about Skype:

- 1 You can make free calls to anywhere in the world.
- 2 You can chat and make calls even when you've run out of credit.
- 3 You just press the Skype button to get going.
- 4 It costs nothing to press the Skype button.

## What is skype™?

Skype is a way of sending phone calls across the mobile internet. And because it's going across the mobile internet it's free. (That means if you're a Pay As You Go customer and you run out of credit or a Pay Monthly customer and you use up your inclusive minutes, you can still make Skype calls for free. Good eh?)

There are already more than 170 million Skype users around the world, and numbers are growing every day.

When you make a Skype call, you use your phone just like normal (except you can only call other people who are Skype users). And your phone can do everything else that other mobiles do as well.

There's one other thing to remember: it costs nothing to press the Skype button.

### Have I got skype?

Skype on a mobile is exclusive to 3 and free to Pay Monthly customers who are on our Mix&Match price plans, and all Pay As You Go customers (as long as you topped up less than 30 days ago).

### A few things to remember...

- › Press the  key on the side of your phone to easily switch between your contacts, call logs, options etc.
- › To make a Skype call, choose your contact and press . Your phone will then connect to Skype, which can take several seconds and your call will be connected.
- › To add a Skype buddy to your contacts, press , select **› Options, › Add a contact**. Then enter the appropriate Skype user name and your phone will store it.
- › To start a Skype chat, press , choose your preferred contact, select **› Options and › Start Chat**. A new messaging window will open and the phone will pause for several seconds as the phone and the internet sync. Then you can start your chat.
- › To return to a Skype chat from anywhere on the handset, press the  and then click  right.
- › To find your previous chats, press  and then click  right.
